## HAMILTON CENTRAL SLO PITCH LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON HOUSE RULES

### GAME DAY RULES

1. All games are 7 innings, time permitting.
2. Regular season games that are tied after 7 innings will remain a tie. No extra innings.
3. All games are scheduled for 1 hour, 15 minutes.
4. Games are scheduled for 75 minutes each but no new inning will start after 1 hour after the intended start time.
  - Game 1 was to start at 6:00pm and no new inning will start after 7:00pm.
  - Game 2 was to start at 7:15pm and no new inning will start after 8:15pm.
5. Five (5) courtesy runners per game in MENS and unlimited for Masters. Any player in your dugout may pitch run. For masters, the same runner can only run once PER inning.
6. There is a 6 run max per inning. Last inning will be open. IF teams are in a mercy, and the amount is more than 6, they are allowed to bat until out of the mercy by 1 run. (IE. If the team is down by 20 in the bottom of the 5th, they can score 9 to be out of the 12 run mercy.
7. Pitching arc is 6 foot minimum to a 12 foot maximum.
8. Third strike foul is an out.
9. Any runner tagged at home plate is safe. Only way to get a runner out at home is the catcher stepping on the plate with the ball beating the runner to the plate.
10. After first inning no infield or practice ball permitted on the field.
11. No anticipation is allowed. Player may not leave the bag until the batter has made contact with the ball. If the player is caught leaving before contact or with no contact the player is out.
12. Limited Home Runs. Each team is allowed 5 over the fence home runs. Auto out for each home run after your 5th one. For NON FENCED diamonds, when the ball passes the light posts IN THE AIR (EASTDALE INCLUDED) it will be deemed a home run. When it ROLLS PAST THE LIGHTS, IT WILL BE A GROUND RULE DOUBLE.

### POSTPONED GAMES (INCLEMENT WEATHER)

13. Only Umpires or City Park Groundkeeper's will postpone games due to rain or any other unsafe reason.
14. If a game is postponed and 1 team has less than 8 players, then this team will forfeit both games regardless and Team fines handed out as per Forfeit Section.
15. If a game is postponed and 2 teams has less than 8 players, then both teams will forfeit both games regardless and Team fines handed out as per Forfeit Section.
16. In the case of rain delayed games it is considered a complete game after five innings or 4 1/2 if the home team is ahead.
17. Games continued under any conditions are the responsibility of the teams and players.

## Zero Tolerance Policy

**The City of Hamilton- Zero Tolerance of Violence Policy**

**Policy Statement**

The City of Hamilton's recreation facilities exist to provide residents with opportunities to participate in sport in a safe and positive environment. The City will ensure the most supportive climate possible for Hamilton children so that they can enjoy their sport and learn about competition, teamwork, sportsmanship and fair play. Hamilton's minor sport system is managed and operated by volunteers. These community-minded citizens contribute in many ways to the success of minor sport in Hamilton. It is the City's responsibility that they too have the ability to work in a safe and positive environment.

It is critical for the City to do all things necessary to ensure that deterrents are in place to ensure that incidents of violent behavior do not occur in its recreation facilities. Included in this commitment is an understanding that organizations that rent City facilities must take PRIMARY responsibility for the behavior of all associated with them: players, officials and spectators.

**Goals of the Policy**

1. To reduce or eliminate violence from City-owned recreation facilities, including outdoor sports pitches.
2. To promote positive cheering behaviors among spectators and fans.
3. To increase the level of understanding among spectators and fans of the importance of creating a positive and supportive environment for children's sport.

**Definition of Violence**

For the purposes of this Policy, the focus is on the behavior of non-players except in a situation in which a player leaves the area of play to engage in a violent act. Violence is seen to be the following behaviors:

- loud verbal assaults
- threats and attempts to intimidate
- throwing of articles in a deliberate or aggressive manner
- aggressive approaches to another individual
- physical striking of another individual
- attempts to goad or incite violence in others

**The Consequences**

Individuals who engage in any of the above behaviors will be subject to immediate ejection from the facility and a further ban from all city facilities for a period of time to be determined by the Director of Culture and Recreation. Incidents may be reported to the Hamilton-Wentworth Regional Police and criminal charges may follow.
